MERITS

- Pupils will act in a responsible and safe manner
- Pupils will meet subject expectations in terms of behaviour
- Pupils will leave all teaching spaces tidy, organised and as they found them
- Pupils will follow all instructions from staff



- Pupils will show a positive attitude towards learning
- Pupils will come to class prepared to learn
- Pupils will attend all classes and arrive on time



- Pupils will work to the best of their ability
- Pupils will offer support and show care for others
- Pupils will be recognised for the quality/effort of their work/homework



DE - MERITS

In line with the expectations placed on pupils, anyone who demonstrates the following will receive de-merits. These will be deducted from the total merit counts of pupils.



- Poor behaviour
- Lack of effort
- Latecoming to class
- Persistently not bring equipment to class (e.g. PE kit for lessons)



Awarding of Merits/De-Merits

Subjects who teach 1 period per week: Award a maximum of 1 merit/demerit per week
Subjects who teach 2-3 periods per week: Award a max of 2 merits/demerits per week
Subjects who teach 4 periods per week: Award a max of 3 merits/demerits per week

Only 1 Merit/De-Merit can be awarded per period and only one reason offered for awarding that merit.
