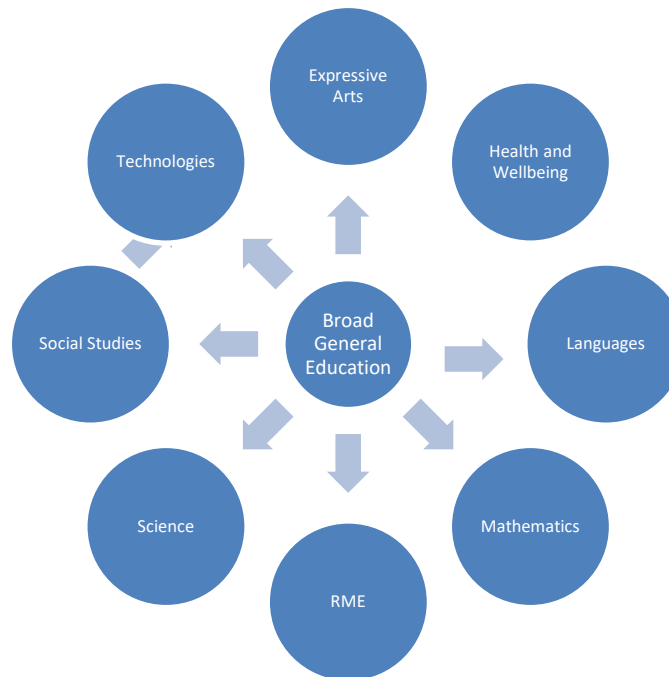
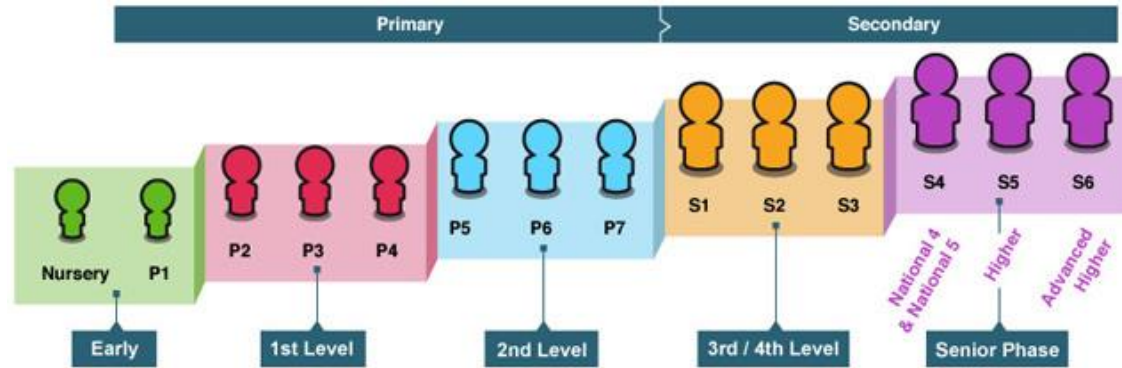

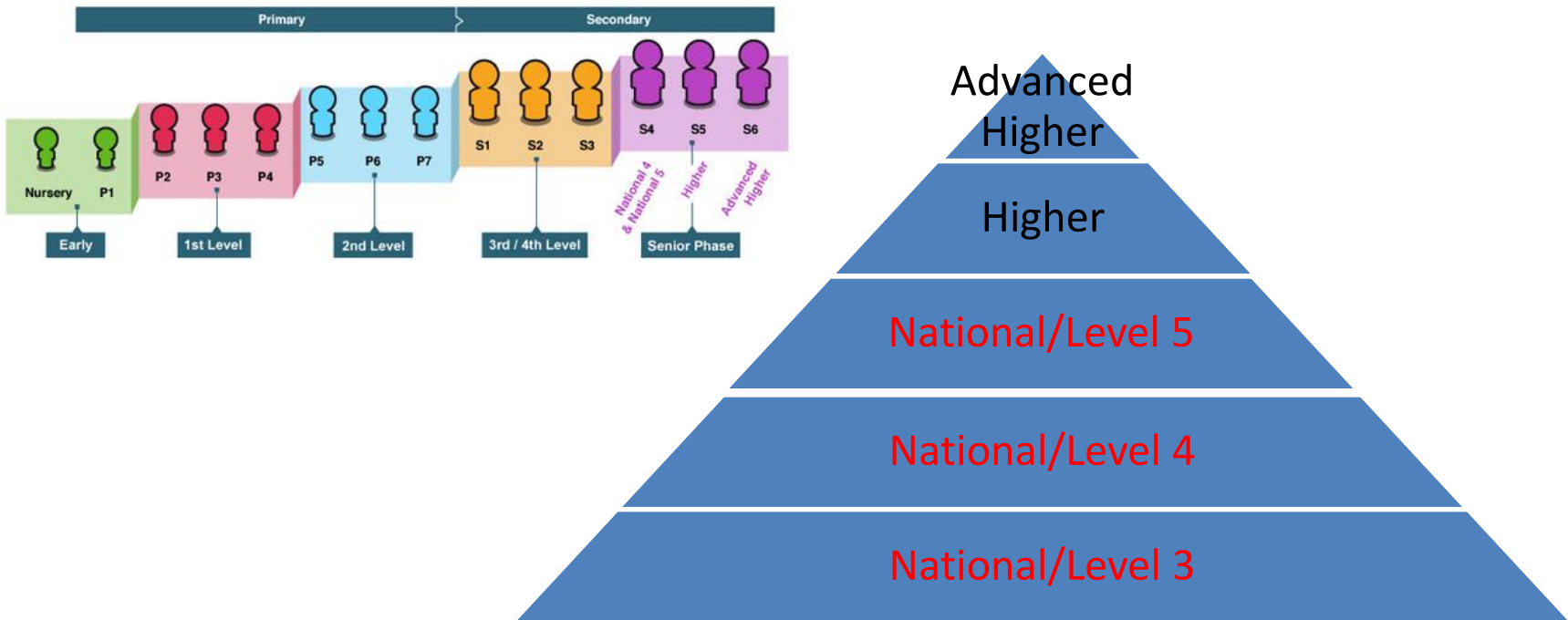
S4-S6: The Senior Phase

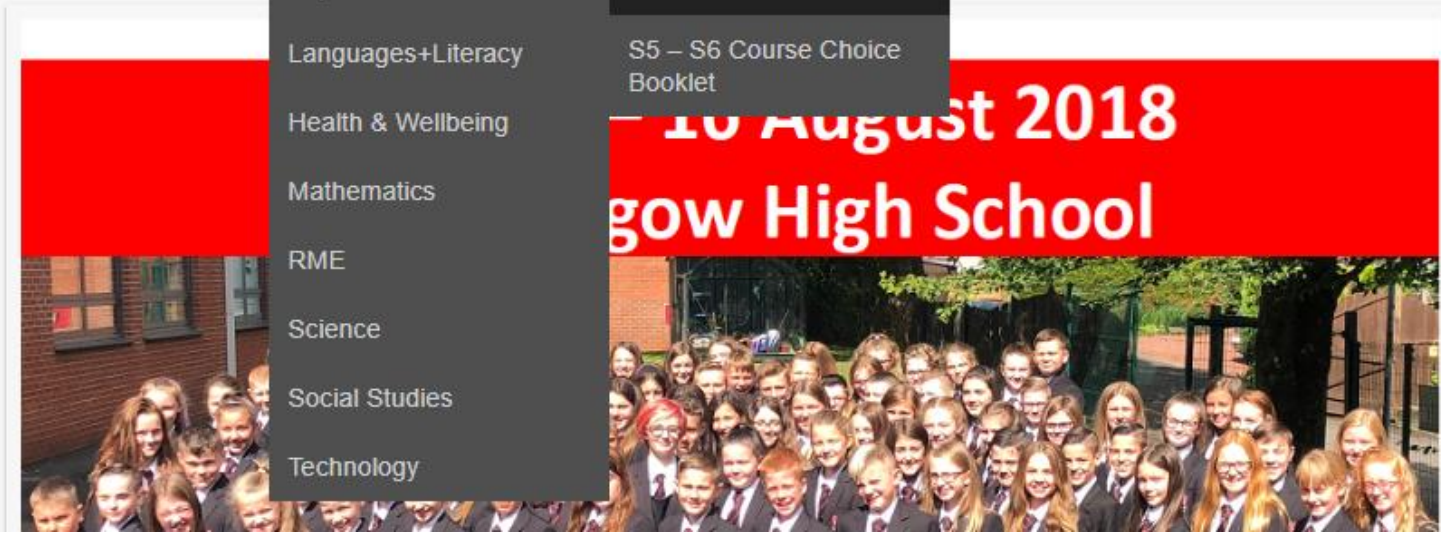

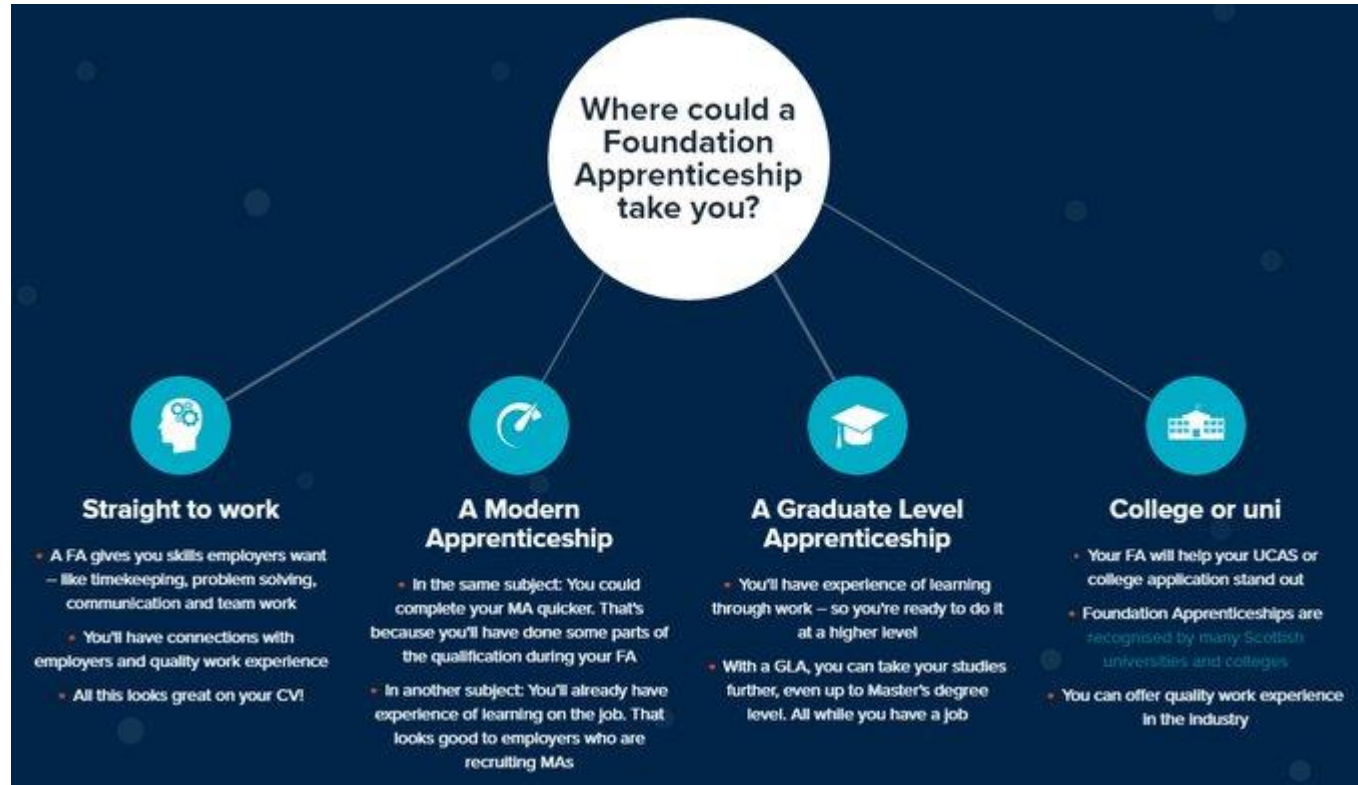
