Senior Phase Update - March 2019

Senior phase students received their latest reports today, along with a copy of the information that SQA currently hold for the subjects they are studying and their personalised exam timetable. Students have been asked to check their SQA information carefully and to let their class teachers and Miss Lee know if anything is incorrect. The full SQA timetable can be viewed at www.sqa.org.uk/timetable Please note: some exams take place on Friday afternoons and the May holiday weekend.

Study leave for all S4-S6 pupils will run from Thursday, 25th April until Friday, 31st May 2019 (inclusive). Throughout this time, students must attend on the days when they have SQA exams. They may also attend supported study classes or come into school for support and advice from their teachers or to complete unfinished assessments. Please note that students must wear full school uniform when they are in school. Students who do not have timetabled exams will be invited to attend master classes to help them to prepare for their studies in the new session. The timetable for our master classes and with the arrangements for our new S5 and S6 induction programme and our S6 Graduation will be confirmed after the spring break.

Students have also received a copy of a booklet from SQA, which gives information about how to prepare for exams, what happens on exam days and results day and also gives a card for them to record their Scottish Candidate Number, which can be taken into the exam hall. In addition, students have received a leaflet about signing up to receive their exam results by text message or email on exam results day (Tuesday, 6th August).

We would also like to remind Senior Phase students who are studying for National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher exams that revision support is offered through our additional learning opportunities and our 'Spring Break Study School', which will run on Monday 1st, Tuesday 2nd and Wednesday 3rd April 2019.
