## MORNING INTERVAL: MON-THURS:11.20-11.35 AM; FRI: 10.30-10.50 AM

Reminder: Students must remain within the school grounds at interval. Gates on Station Road and School Road are locked between the start of the school day and lunch-time for security reasons. Please use the gates on Strathaven Road if you arrive late or need to leave the school early.

The canteen serves a wide variety of food and drinks at interval. There are also vending machines within the Street area and S6 Common Room area.

Any student who feels unwell during interval must speak to the Head Teacher or one of the Depute Head Teachers before going to the school office. The school office will then contact home.

The Street area can be very busy at interval times. Excellent behaviour is expected from all students at all times.

## LUNCH-TIME: MON-THURS: 1.15-1.55 PM

A bell will ring at 1.53 pm to remind you to start moving to your Period 6 class.
