Pupil Equity Fund 2019-20

Our Acting Principal Teacher (Equity – Raising Attainment). Our 2019-20 allocation of money is to £44,400.

Pupil Equity Funding is additional funding allocated directly to schools and targeted at closing the poverty-related attainment gap. The Scottish Government has committed to this funding as part of the Scottish Attainment Challenge programme from 2017/18. The Pupil Equity Funding forms part of the £750m Attainment Scotland Fund which will be invested over the current Parliamentary term. Pupil Equity Funding will continue until the end of this Parliament. The funding should be focused on activities and interventions that will lead to improvements in literacy, numeracy and health and wellbeing.

Pupil Achievements (In School and out of school)

We are planning to create a system within school to log pupil successes in school and out of school in order to track and celebrate achievement success of our young people as well as attainment.
