
S3 Curriculum Consultation

Following our curriculum consultation earlier this year, changes were made to the Senior Phase curriculum and the structure of the school day. This included introducing tutor time, increasing the number of S4 options from 6 to 7, altering the number of periods allocated to National and Higher courses and introducing short courses. It was agreed that changes to the Broad General Education would follow along with further refinements to improve learner pathways using other Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF) courses, based on labour market information.

In S1-S3, pupils continue to study the Broad General Education. In S3, our curriculum already provides opportunities for personalisation and choice, mainly within curricular areas, which enables our pupils' entitlement to third and fourth level experiences and outcomes in all curricular areas to be met. It was previously agreed that during the course of S3, pupils would have the opportunity through blended learning to progress to courses leading to SCQF rated courses, with S4 options then allowing pupils to refine their curriculum to seven subjects (plus core entitlements) based on their learner pathway.

When reviewing our S3 curriculum, in line with the refreshed narrative for CfE (https://scotlandscurriculum.scot/4/), it is necessary for us to ensure that pupils' entitlement to study Modern Languages until the end of S3, with opportunities for Language 3, as stated in Languages 1+2, are fully met. As such, we need to review the current curriculum structure. Figure 1, below, shows the changes this would make to the overall school week for S3 students. On this diagram, TT represents the time given to Tutor Time.
