931,800 jobs

Glasgow City Region: 0.4%

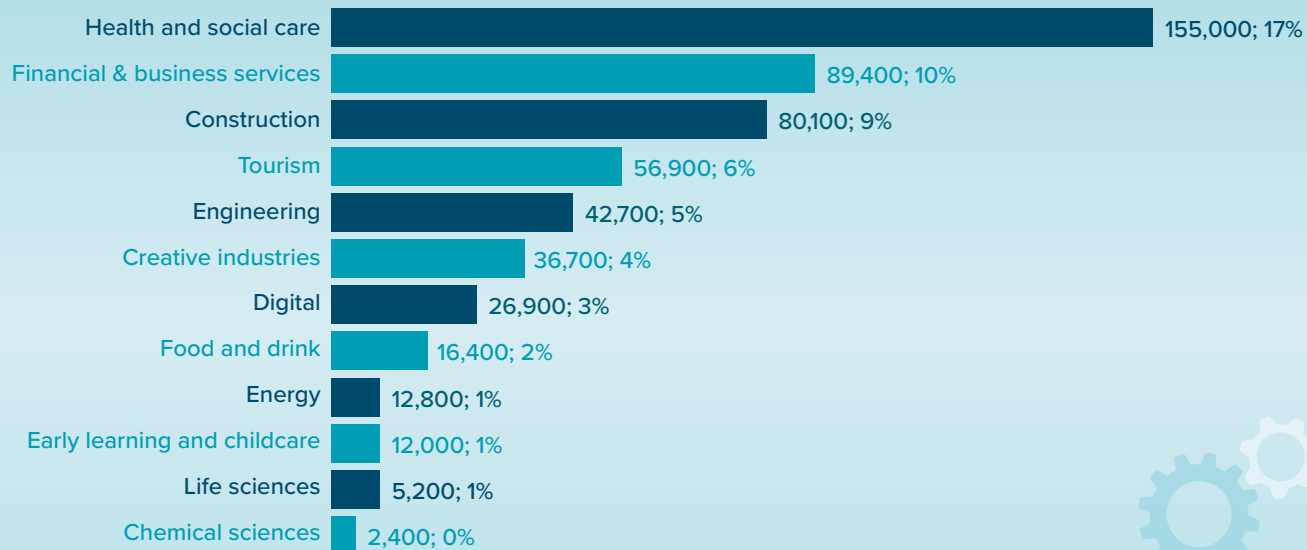
Scotland: 0.3%

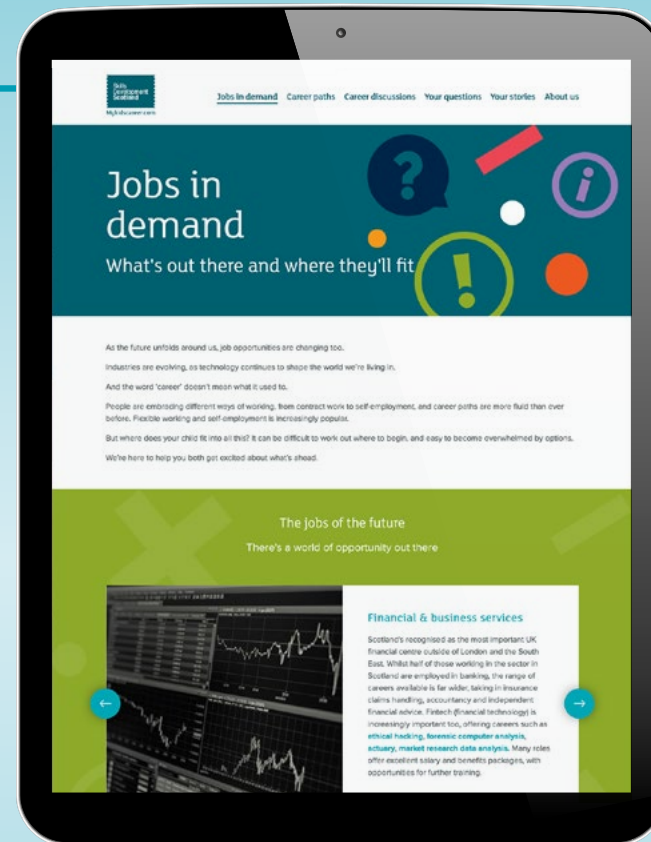
