Lesmahagow High School Prom – Friday 29th May

S6 have chosen the Bothwell Bridge Hotel, Bothwell, as the venue for their Prom. A non-refundable deposit was paid earlier in the year and the remaining budget has been agreed at £52 per person. This includes the costs of the meal, DJ, decorations, Ceilidh band, photographer and transport to and from the event.

The remaining cost of £52 can be made in one payment or in instalments through ParentPay, using the details provided. All students are asked to pay at least £20 by Friday, 14th February, a further £17 by Friday, 13th March and the final £15 by Friday, 3rd April. Should there be any difficulties in meeting these payment deadlines, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

12:30am –	Bus arrives at LHS

Students understand that in order to participate in the Prom, their attendance and conduct throughout the year and in the lead up to the Prom must meet with our agreed expectations as outlined in the Learner Agreement that each student signed in June 2019. A copy of our S5/6 Learner Agreement can be viewed overleaf. SMT will be speaking with all S6 pupils to remind them about the required expectations of excellent standards including behaviour in order to attend prom. Any student whose attendance or conduct causes concern will not be allowed to participate in the Prom. Should this happen, the school cannot be responsible for any costs that have already been incurred by families relating to the Prom. We seek your support in reinforcing these key messages and supporting our school in maintaining high standards.

Welcome back! We hope that you have a fantastic experience in S5/6 where you are able to maximise all of the opportunities presented to you, whether they are sporting, curricular, volunteering or as a member of the pupil leadership team. We hope to support you to reach your goals and achieve your aspirations.

As a senior student, we have high expectations of you! You are expected to assume proper responsibility for your own education. **Persistence, determination and hard work** are key to success in S5 and S6.
