General Information & Requirements

- Pupils need to visit the Work Experience section of Barclays LifeSkills site and complete modules to accumulate 250 points prior to visiting with us <u>https://www.barclayslifeskills.com/</u>
- Work Experience is for 14-19 year olds
- We normally run 4-5 day placements for up to 4 pupils at a time
- Our Work Experience sessions will take place throughout the Glasgow campus which will include our Bothwell Street, Bath Street and West Campbell Street offices. In some sessions, the pupils will also have the opportunity to visit our Argyle Street Retail Branch.
- The pupils will experience a diverse schedule, training with several different teams over the course of the placement
- The days normally run from 9-4 with 1 hour for lunch, if we have scheduled a later start time or early finish on any particular day we'll let the pupils know in advance
- Dress is business dress or school uniform
- Pupils can purchase lunch on site, in the local area or bring a packed lunch
- Pupils must bring photographic ID on their first day
