# **Existing IDL PUPILS (LITERACY)**

1. If you have a log in for IDL Literacy already then you log in the same way and you will be able to do the maths as well.

You can access the web based version of the IDL intervention by visiting: <a href="https://appuk.idlsgroup.com/#/login">https://appuk.idlsgroup.com/#/login</a> and logging in with your IDL account details.

Please ensure you are using the <u>Google Chrome browser</u> - this is the only browser compatible with the IDL programme.

Your user-name and password for IDL have not changed; simply log in to your account in the usual way.

- 2. By pressing the 'Numeracy' button, you will get a "test" first time (the test is on the programme). The test will stop you after 3 consecutive mistakes or 5 in total and then when you click on Numeracy you will get appropriate lessons for you.
- 3. You can access the IDL app by searching for & downloading "IDL2 Mobile" on the App Store or Play Store.
