READINESS TO LEARN FROM HOME – Senior Phase Students

LEARNER INFORMATION LEAFLET – HELPFUL HINTS

Happy New Year! We hope that you have had a restful and relaxing Christmas holiday.

As you will have seen in the news, it is necessary for you to continue your learning on-line for now, using Google Classroom. You should already be a member of each of your Google Classrooms, however, a reminder of how to access these is provided below.

To access your Google Classrooms, you should go to <https://glow.rmunify.com/> and use the Class Codes shared with you by email. Year group Google Classrooms will also be used to share information to all pupils. If logging on from a phone, your password will be the same, but it is necessary to change the ending of your Glow email address to @sl.glow.scot

Where possible, you should follow your 'winter timetable' and focus on up to four subjects each day. When following the 'even week' timetable, this will be your period 1, 2, 4 and 6 classes. When following the 'odd week' timetable, this will be your period 1, 3, 5 and 7 classes. You will follow the 'even week' timetable in the week beginning 11th January, the 'odd week' timetable in the week beginning 18th January and the 'even week' timetable in the week beginning 25th January 2021.

Teachers will upload work to Google classrooms ready for you to access on each school day. Your teachers will be available to answer questions during the school day via email or the Google Classroom Stream. Responses may not be instant, but they will try to respond as quickly as possible.
