Please ensure you are using the **Google Chrome browser** - this is the only browser compatible with the IDL programme.

Your user-name and password for IDL have not changed; simply log in to your account in the usual way.

2. By pressing the 'Numeracy ' button, you will get a "test" first time (the test is on the programme). The test will stop you after 3 consecutive mistakes or 5 in total and then when you click on Numeracy you will get appropriate lessons for you.
3. You can access the IDL app by searching for & downloading "IDL2 Mobile" on the App Store or Play Store.
