#### Hand washing/sanitising

Pupils will be reminded to wash or sanitise their hands when arriving at school, when arriving and leaving each class, before eating and when leaving school at the end of the day.

## **Lateral Flow Testing**

All pupils and staff are encouraged to participate in the lateral flow testing programme as part of our Covid-19 risk reduction mitigations. Test kits are available from the school office on Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> August between 9 am and 3 pm and on Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> August between 9 am and 12.30 pm. During term time, lateral flow test kits can be collected from Mrs McCallum and Mrs Maxwell in the Street area before school, at interval or lunch-times, or from the medical room.
