On the Council website, click on 'Education and Learning', then 'Secondary School Information', then 'Education Maintenance Allowance'. It is your responsibility to complete and send the application form.

When you receive an award letter with your EMA number on it, bring this to Mr Robertson who will then issue a copy of the Learning Agreement to be signed by your teachers and Parent/Carer.
