

The BGE Curriculum

- S1 to S3 is known as the Broad General Education (BGE)
- S3 is a year of transition as pupils prepare to move into the Senior Phase

 The Senior Phase runs from S4 to S6.





Curriculum in S3

- In S3 pupils have the opportunity to personalise some areas of their curriculum.
- Pupils maintain a breadth of curriculum by continuing to study from the following key areas of the curriculum:

Languages Social Studies

Mathematics Sciences

Health and Wellbeing Expressive Arts

RMPS Technologies

- All pupils will continue to study English, Maths, PE, RME and PSE
- They will have the opportunity to deepen their learning by making **6** subject choices within Social Studies, Sciences, Expressive Arts, Technologies and Modern Languages.

Fulfilling the National Entitlements

- Pupils not selecting a Modern Language as one of their options, will still experience this through the Masterclasses.

S4


 Pupils will study a minimum of 7 subjects in S4 (chosen from their S3 courses).


